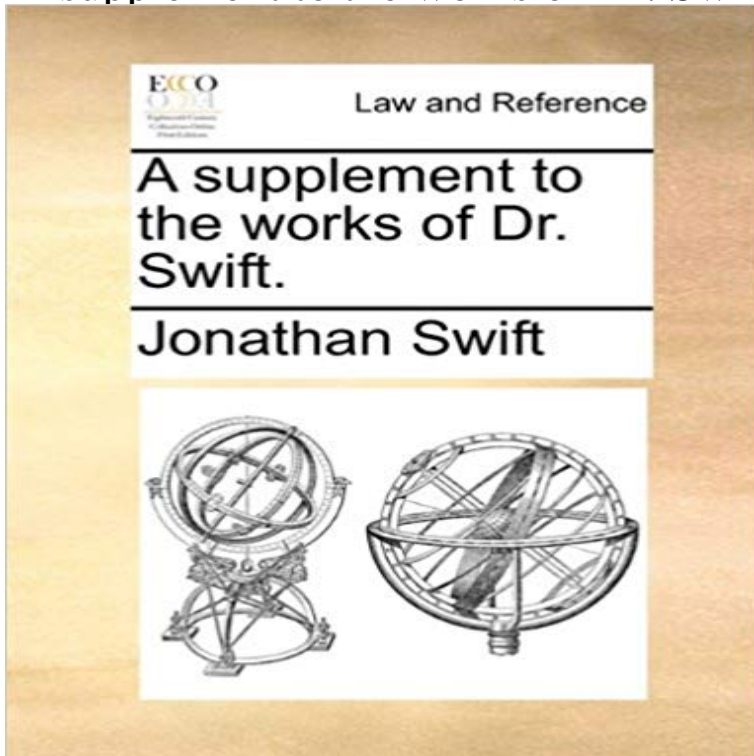


## A supplement to the works of Dr. Swift.
