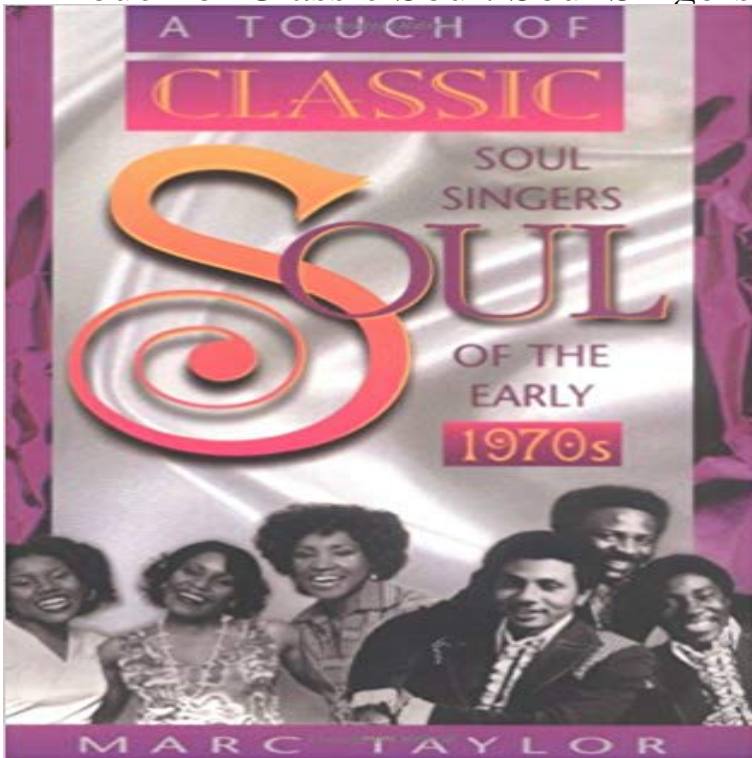


A Touch of Classic Soul: Soul Singers of the Early 1970s

Includes Al Green, the Delfonics, Isaac Hayes, the OJays, Barry White, the Spinners, Gladys Knight and the Pips, the Dells, the Ohio Players, the Stylistics, the Emotions and more. Author Marc Taylor often had to catch artists backstage, on-tour, or for example interviewing Blue Magic at 2:00 after a performance.
