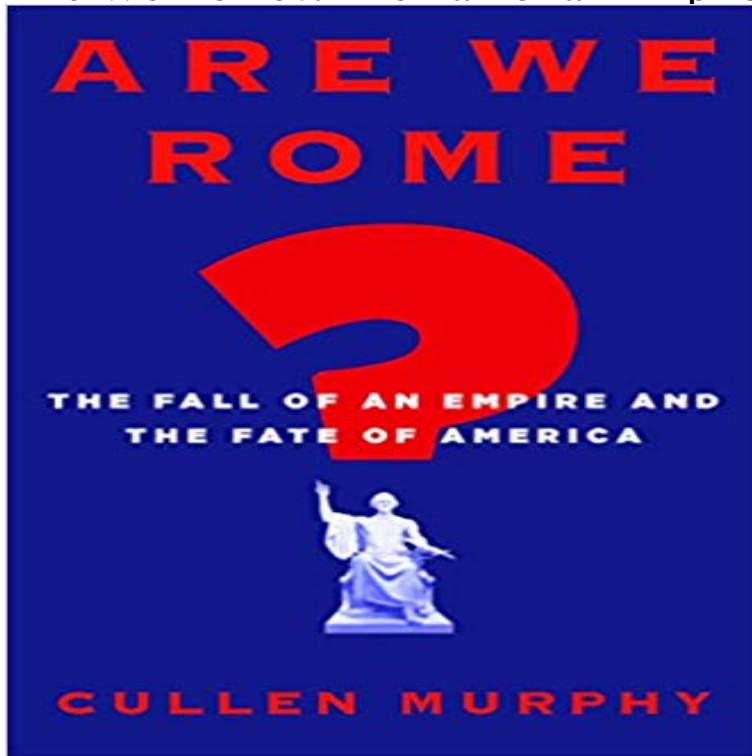


## Are We Rome?: The Fall of an Empire and the Fate of America
