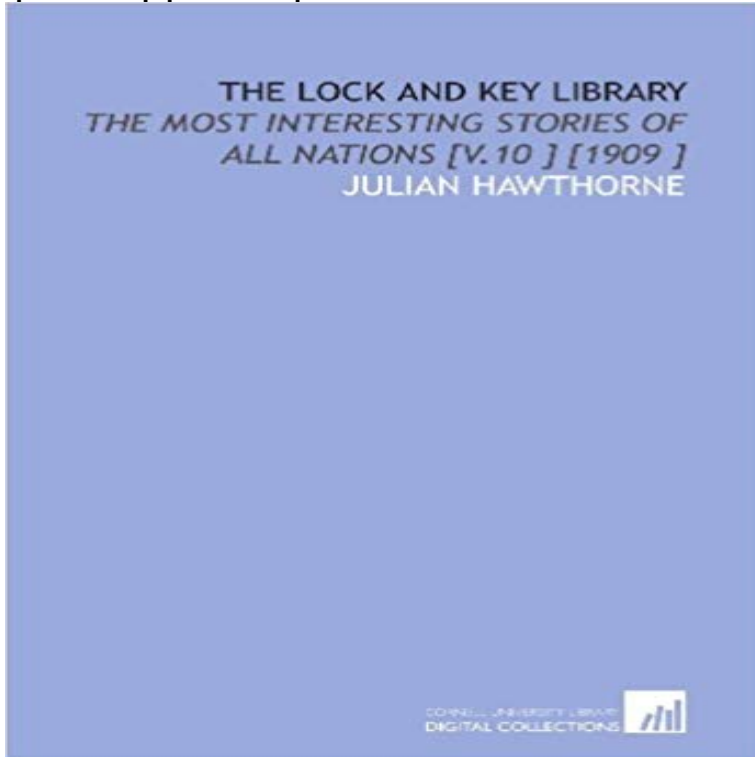


The Lock and Key Library: The Most Interesting Stories of All Nations [V.10] [1909]
