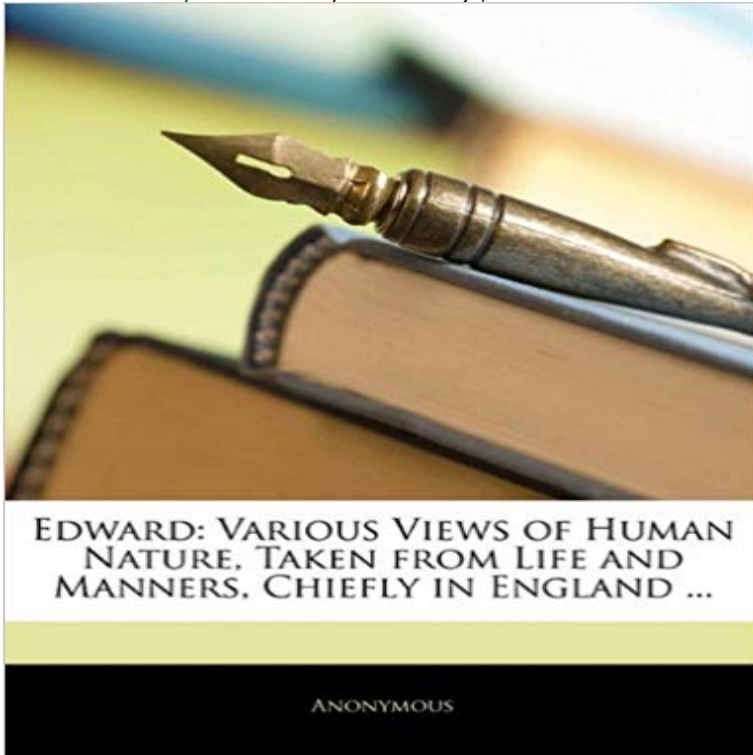


Edward: Various Views of Human Nature, Taken from Life and Manners, Chiefly in England ...
