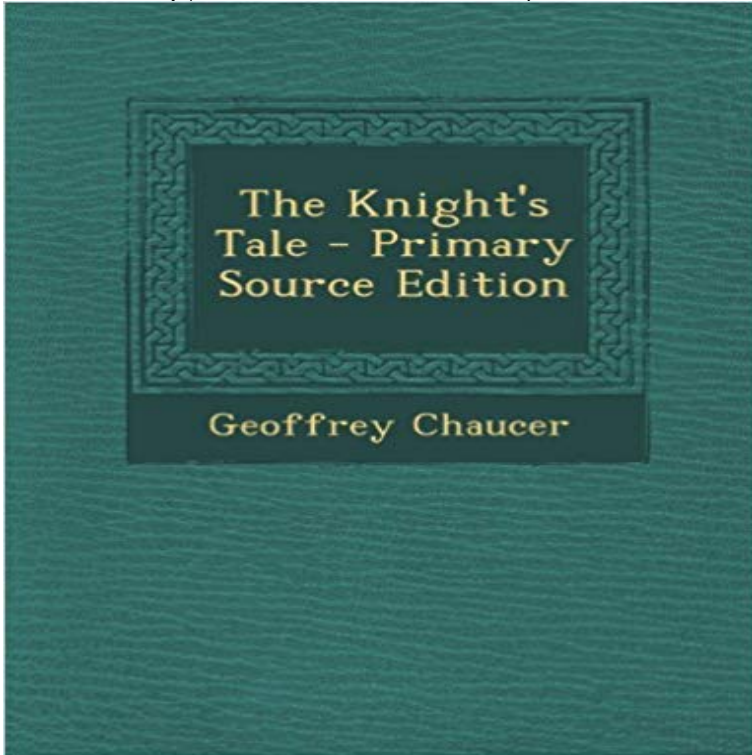


The Knights Tale - Primary Source Edition
