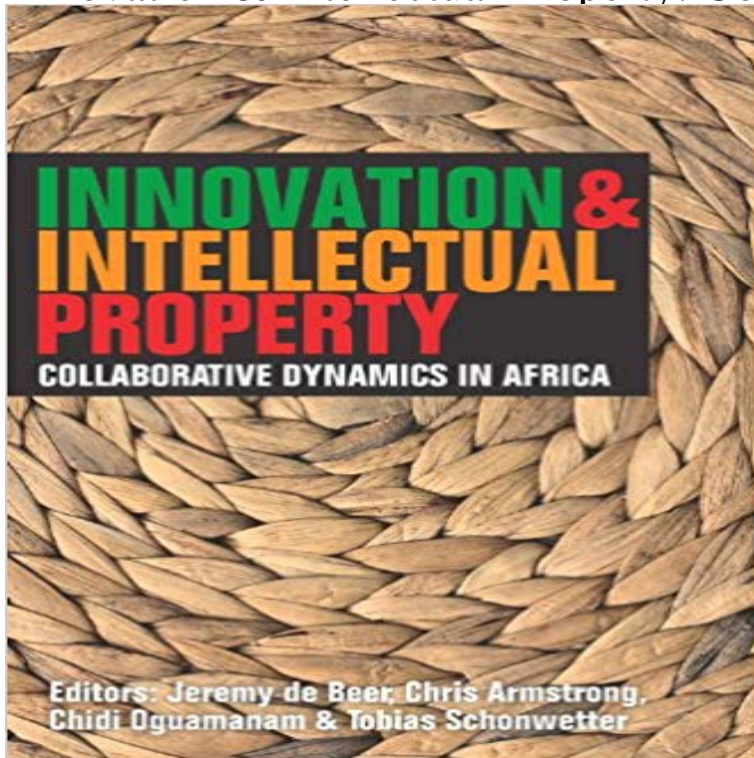


Innovation & Intellectual Property: Collaborative Dynamics in Africa
