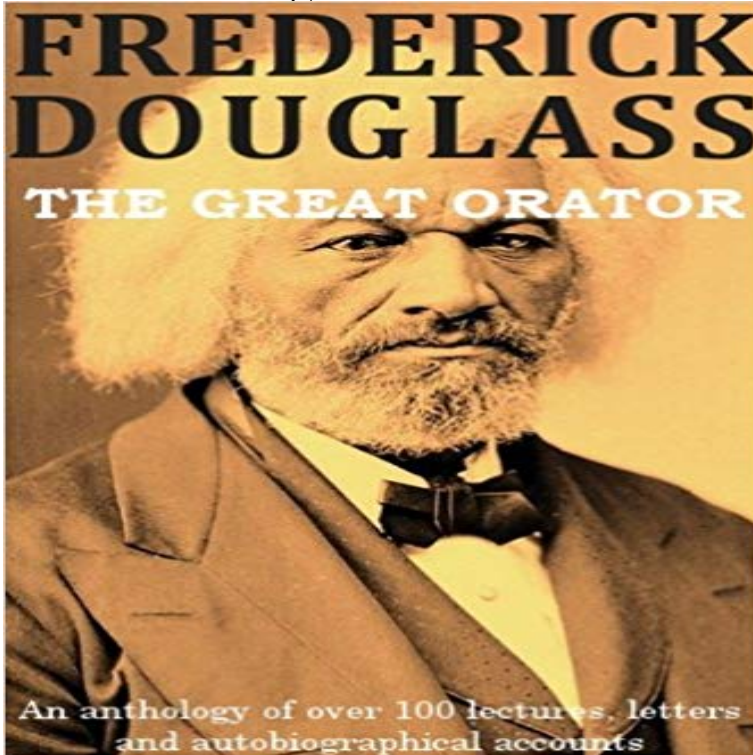


Frederick Douglass: The Great Orator (optimized for Kindle)
