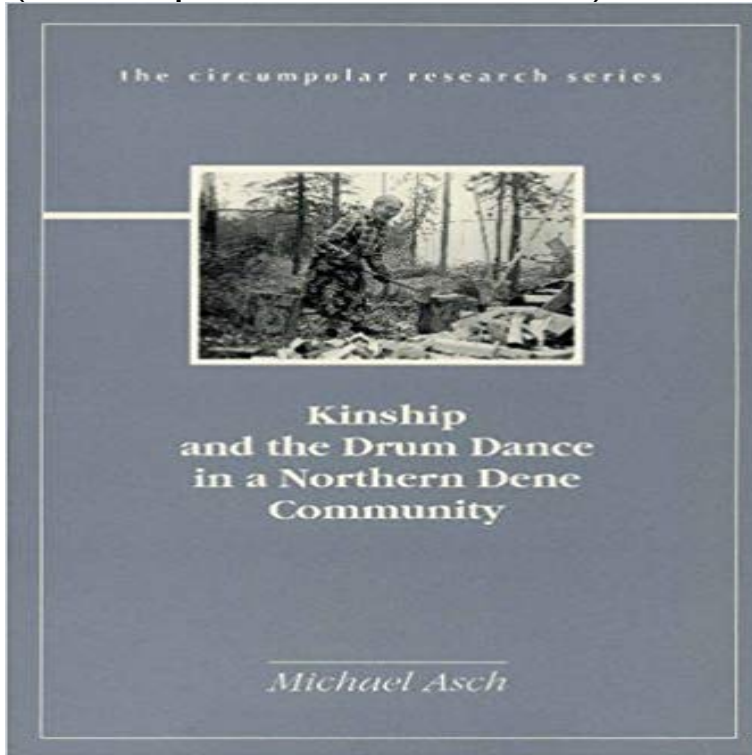


# Kinship & the Drum Dance in a Northern Dene Community (Circumpolar Research Series)
