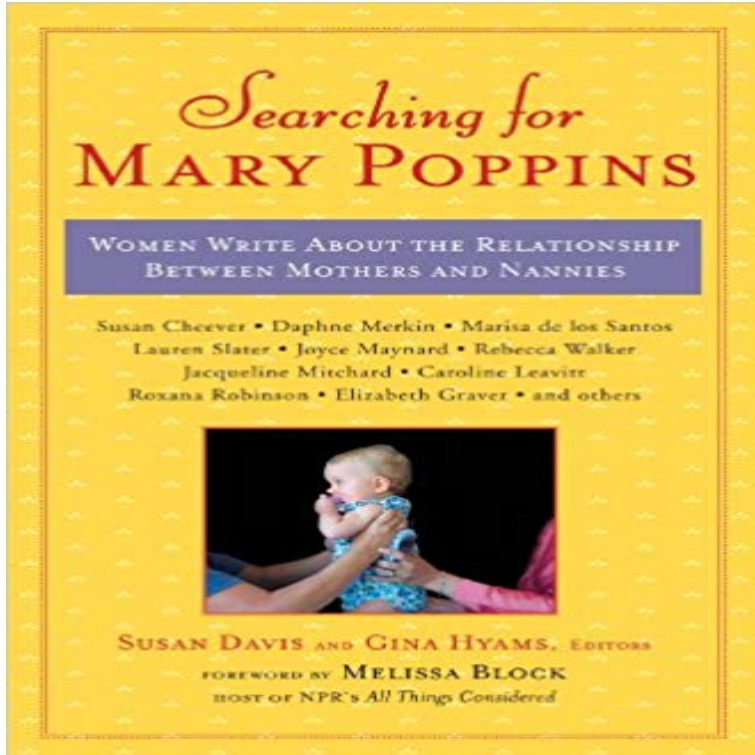


Searching for Mary Poppins: Women Write About the Relationship Between Mothers and Nannies
