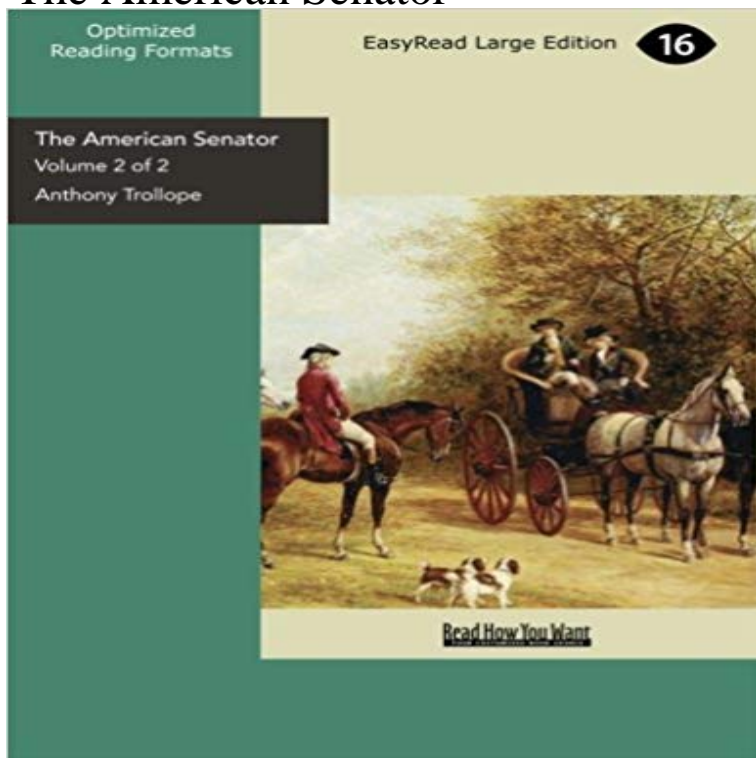


# The American Senator
