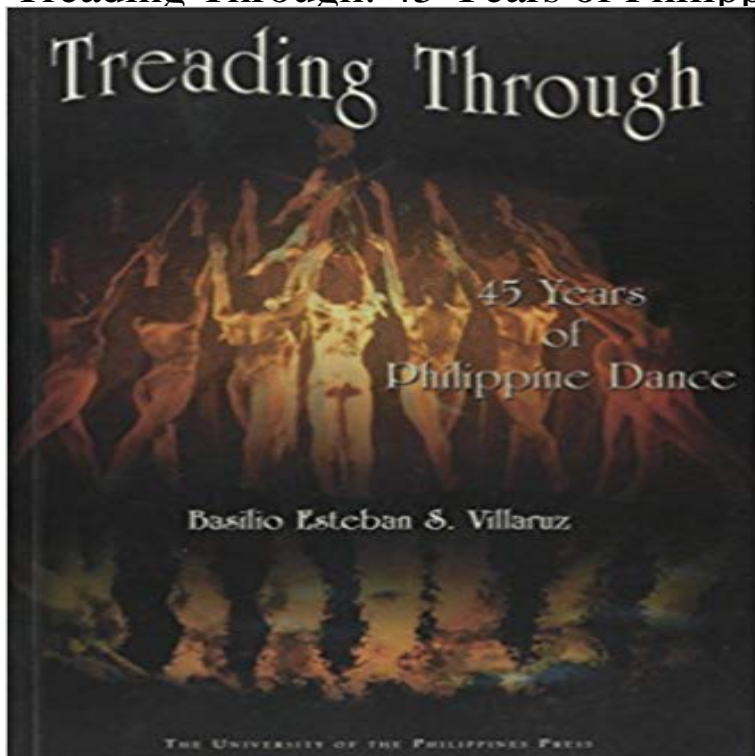


Treading Through: 45 Years of Philippine Dance
