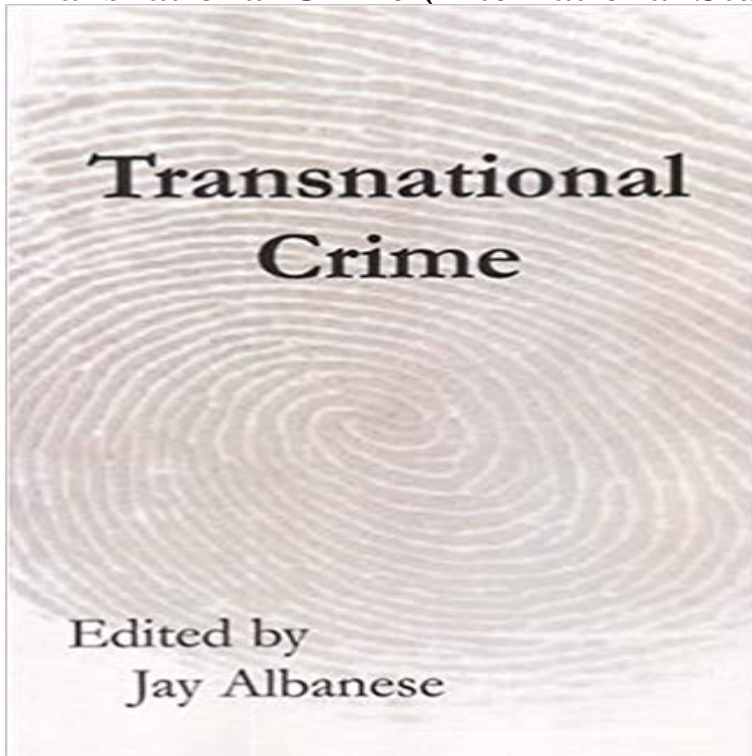


## Transnational Crime (International Studies in Social Science)
