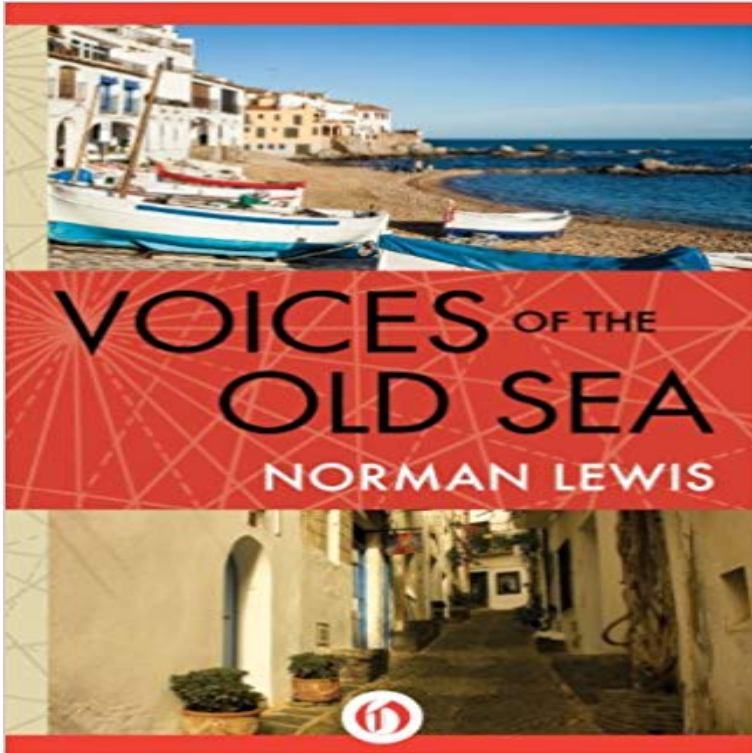


Voices of the Old Sea

Seeking solace in the everyday after his World War II army service, travel writer Norman Lewis returns to his beloved Spain, to the fishing village of Farol, in the hopes of recapturing a lost sense of home. He spends three seasons as a fisherman, basking in the simplicity of village customs. Lovingly written and richly evocative, *Voices of the Old Sea* is an absorbing look at a centuries-old lifestyle in its final days, as the tide of modernization threatens to change it forever.
