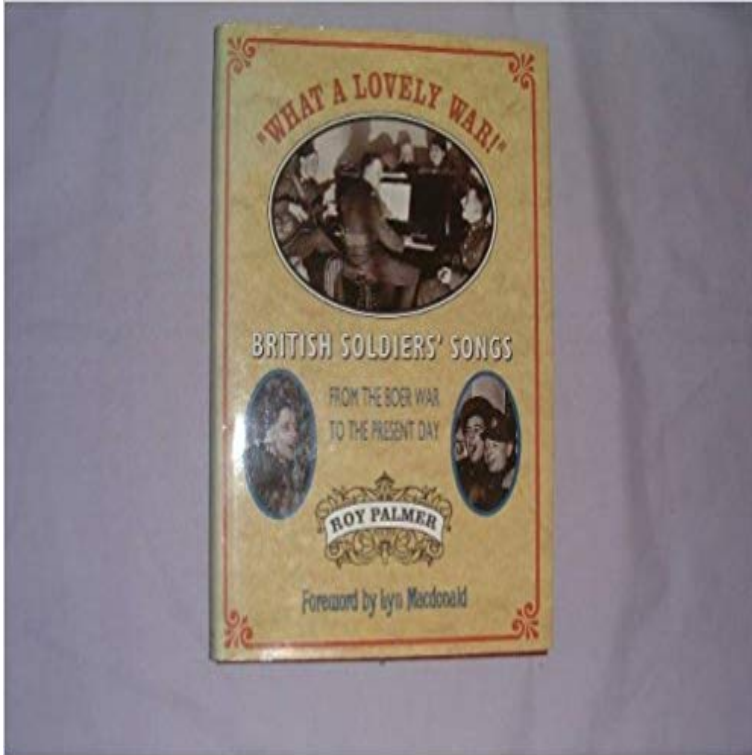


What a Lovely War: British Soldiers Songs from the Boer War to the Present Day
