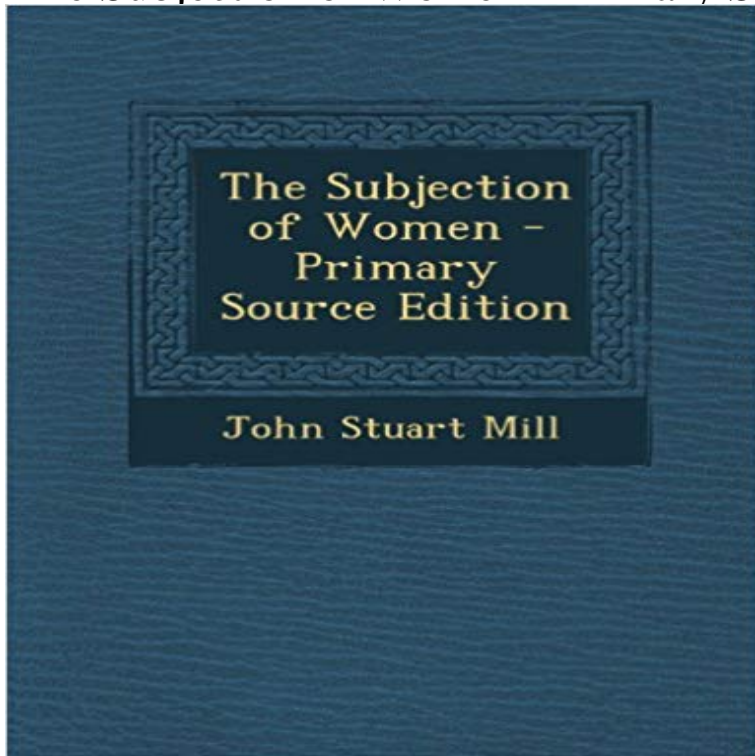


The Subjection of Women - Primary Source Edition
